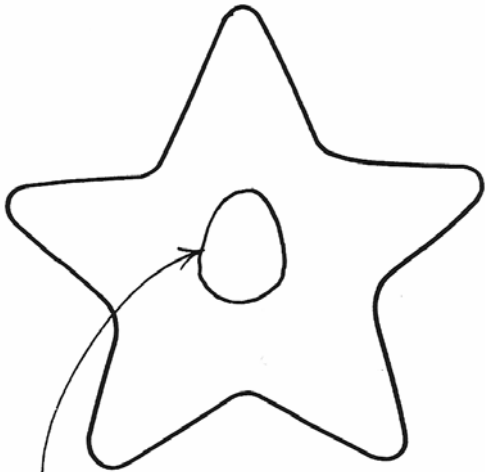
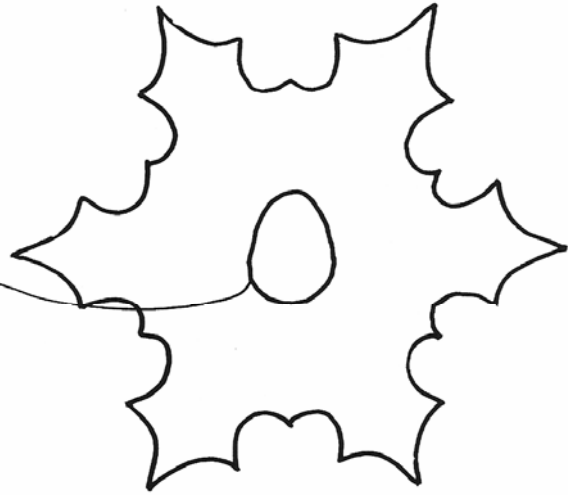


HEAD OUTLINE

SNOWFLAKE TEMPLATE

Snowflake and Star Holiday Pins

Materials and Supplies:

(Amounts given for one pin)

1. 5" by 10" piece of white felt
2. 2" by 4" piece of flesh-colored cotton broadcloth
3. White thread
4. Soft lead pencil
5. Tacky glue
6. Glitter paint (Heavy Metals clear glimmer or Scribbles glittering crystal)
7. Glitter (Prisma Stardust clear or blue)
8. Brown gel pen or permanent pen or sharp brown pencil
9. Red gel pen or sharp red pencil
10. White gel pen or sharp white pencil
11. Pink pencil or blusher
12. Light box or window
13. Masking tape or Scotch tape
14. Small amount of fiber fill.

The star is turned inside out, the snowflake is not.

Try out your pens on the fabric first, some will bleed.

Directions...

You may want to glue the snowflake, star and head outline to card stock and cut it out for added stability.

1. Use soft lead pencil to draw around the head outline template onto the flesh colored fabric.
2. Tape the face onto a window or light box, center the marked side of the head outline over the face and trace onto the fabric with the brown pen/pencil.
3. Fill in the lips with red, use white on inside of mouth for teeth and color the cheeks pink with the pink pencil or blusher.
4. Cover the face side with another piece of flesh-colored broadcloth and stitch along the face outline, leaving the top open for stuffing.
5. Turn inside out, stuff lightly with fiber fill and stitch the top closed.
6. Place pattern for star or snowflake on white felt, draw around with pencil, and sew directly on line. Mark hole for face on star, TURN OVER and mark hole for face on other side for snowflake.
7. Cut out 1/8" from edge, cut an X on the back and cut out hole for face.
8. Pin the corners of the X back and run a bead of glue around the inside edge of the face opening.
9. Center the face in the opening, press down the edges and let dry.
10. Fill the snowflake or star with fiber fill and stitch the X closed.
11. Sew or glue a pin back to the back or sew a safety pin to the back (safety pins are easier on clothes.)
12. Paint white felt with glitter paint and sprinkle immediately with glitter.
